JAVITS JUNIORS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM EXPANDS TO OFFER FIVE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS TO SENIORS AT TWO CTE-FOCUSED MANHATTAN HIGH SCHOOLS

Second Year of Scholarship Program Includes \$25,000 in Donations from the Marian B. and Jacob K. Javits Foundation and Three Event Industry Leaders, Emerald Expositions, Informa and Reed Exhibitions

Members of Senior Classes at Urban Assembly School of Design and Construction and High School of Fashion Industries Eligible for Five \$5,000 College Scholarships

NEW YORK (April 2, 2019) – The Marian B. and Jacob K. Javits Foundation and the New York Convention Center Operating Corporation (NYCCOC), which operates the Javits Center, today announced the second year of the Javits Juniors Scholarship Program, an effort designed to support the higher education of local high school students and encourage them to seek ways to improve their community through public service and innovative thinking. With the support of three leading event producers, Emerald Expositions, Informa and Reed Exhibitions, the scholarship program has expanded in its second year, allowing the award of five \$5,000 college scholarships to three students at Urban Assembly School of Design and Construction and two students at High School of Fashion Industries, both located on Manhattan's West Side. Each event producer has funded a \$5,000 scholarship, and the Marian B. and Jacob K. Javits Foundation has funded two scholarships – which are eligible to all seniors at the participating schools following an essay writing contest. The scholarship program is being coordinated through the Fund for Public Schools, a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting the New York City's public schools, and the New York City Department of Education.

"These scholarships have a tremendous impact on the future of these students, and we are thrilled to see the number of scholarships expand this year," said Alan Steel, President and CEO of the New York Convention Center Operating Corporation. To be considered for a scholarship, students must participate in an essay contest entitled "Serving New York" and outline public policy ideas that would better serve the general public and improve the quality of life for New Yorkers, as well as the reasons behind their goals and the steps necessary to achieve them. Essays will be reviewed by a selection committee comprised of members from the Javits Center, the Marian B. and Jacob K. Javits Foundation and the participating schools. The committee will choose five winners, who will be awarded a







\$5,000 scholarship to the college or university of their choosing. Winning essays will be judged on logic and feasibility, originality and creativity, clarity of ideas and structure.

The Urban Assembly School for Design and Construction and High School of Fashion Industries focus on providing high-quality Career and Technical Education (CTE) experiences to their students, offering rigorous academics, while also providing them with authentic workbased learning experiences that foster the skills necessary to succeed in careers. Aligned to the theme of "Serving New York," Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs train students to compete as candidates for careers in booming sectors of New York City's economy. The scholarships will create a strong postsecondary bridge to successful careers for students as well as high quality talent for a wide range of local employers.

The scholarship program is coordinated through the Javits Juniors program at the Javits Center, where educational tours are provided regularly to local students and community groups. On these tours, students are taught about the career of Senator Javits, the mission and operations of the convention center, the importance of public service and the impact of the events industry on the region's economy. The Javits Center opened its doors in 1986, the same year that Senator Javits passed away at the age of 81 in Palm Beach, Fla., following a storied career as New York State Attorney General, U.S. Congressman and U.S. Senator.
